



2023 Summer Math and Grammar Assignment

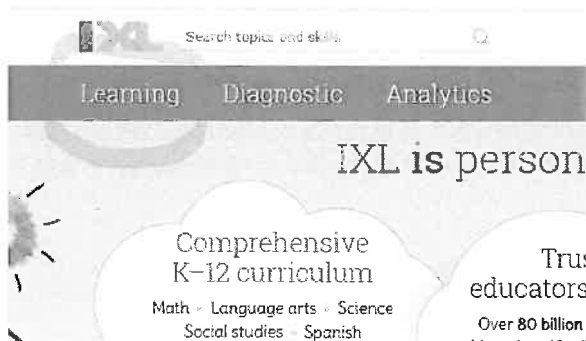
Dear Blessed Sacrament Families,

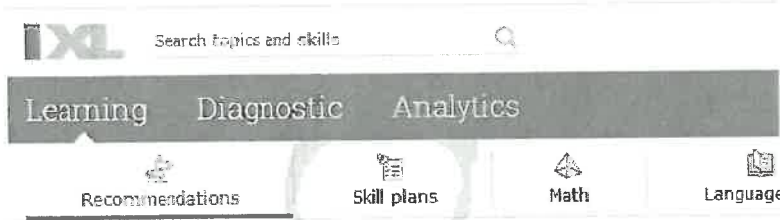
