You may work at your own pace, but the preferred method is to practice a little each day. There is no need to keep a paper record of your ixl.com practice. Your teacher has access to your progress. This assignment is **required** for students entering grades 4-8 and will be the first graded math and language arts assignment for the 2021-2022 school year. If you are unable to complete this assignment due to summer plans, you **MUST** have a parent communicate with the school. An alternate assignment will be given. It is highly recommended that students entering grades K-3 complete the summer assignments.
