

# Blessed Sacrament Academic Bridge Camp

This camp is available for all rising kindergarten to 4<sup>th</sup> grade students. Blessed Sacrament teachers will organize engaging academic, social, and athletic activities for campers. It is a great way for children to bridge the summer months, learn teambuilding and athletic skills, while have fun with their school friends over the summer.

Students will explore various themes throughout the summer months. Each week's snack, activities, and games will focus on a specific theme. Please see themes below. Students will be grouped according to grade level as they rotate through four exciting activities each day! They will begin the day as a large group, eat snack and lunch together, and will meet back on the Field of Dreams to end each day with fun and games! In their small groups, they will engage in math activities to develop their computation and critical thinking skills, dive into a good book to build fluency and comprehension, employ their creative side to create masterpieces and meet on the field for "summer training."

## ***Each week will include:***

An engaging program of academic enrichment focused on Language Arts and Math concepts. This will enhance skills over the summer months and challenge students before they move on to the next grade. For students who are struggling at the end of the year, we will offer focused instruction to bridge them to the next grade. For those looking for a challenge, we will have interactive activities to further stimulate their academic development. This program will focus on hands-on instruction and engaging centers to ensure the children are interested and motivated in a fun, learning environment.

This camp will offer the children an introduction to new sports and games that will help them develop social and athletic skills. Each week we will introduce the children to different sports. This will allow them to develop and refine their skills as they practice drills, learn techniques, and play games.
